Re: Unauthorized Dissemination of Qualcomm's Intellectual Property

Dear Administrator:

Qualcomm Incorporated (Qualcomm) requests your immediate attention and response to this letter.

Qualcomm has recently discovered the unauthorized publication, disclosure, and copying of its confidential trade secret and/or copyright-protected documents at the following locations on your web site:

The unauthorized copying, disclosure and distribution of Qualcomm's confidential trade secret and/or copyright-protected documents constitute a violation of both civil and criminal trade secret and copyright laws. If you are disseminating or aiding and abetting the dissemination of these documents, you are violating Qualcomm's intellectual property rights, and could be subject to severe civil and criminal penalties.

Specifically, we believe that the following documents available on your web site are confidential and proprietary to Qualcomm:

The above filenames and URLs should provide you with sufficient information to identify the intellectual property at issue.

Based on our preliminary investigation, we believe that you are responsible for this unauthorized publication, disclosure, and copying and that this web site is owned and/or controlled by you. Qualcomm, therefore, demands that you immediately (1) cease making Qualcomm's confidential trade secret and/or copyright-protected documents (including but not limited to the above-referenced documents) available on any of the web sites under your control, or otherwise distributing them, and (2) destroy any and all copies of such documents that you may have in your possession.

We request that you take appropriate action against the account holders and/or users responsible for uploading Qualcomm's confidential trade secret and/or copyright-protected documents to prevent any future violations. We further request that you forward this notice promptly to all such account holders and/or users.

Qualcomm takes these issues very seriously, and will pursue legal action against individuals and organizations that take part in the unauthorized dissemination of its confidential trade secret and/or copyright-protected documents. We look forward to your prompt cooperation. If there is any ambiguity as to which materials should be removed or if you have other questions, please contact me by June 30, 2010.
